
I was so pleased with the result, I built all my main top boxes using the same duel concentric, with the addition of 2  $\times$  10" low mid drivers. However, although the duel concentrics are fantastic quality, in venues over

However, although the duel concentrics are fantastic quality, in venues over 600 people the tweets run out of steam without a horn, so I've re-done my top boxes with horns, and used the duel concentrics for some new monitor speakers, with a high power sub driver from Italy.

## DESIGN -





Based on my DC3 top boxes, but shorter & wider to accommodate the 12" bass cone instead of the 2 x 10" low mid cones.

Curved baffle to eliminate 'edge diffraction'

Roundy box shape to eliminate 90degree angles, internal standing waves, and increase structural rigidity.

## CONSTRUCTION -



Designed in AutoCad, then precision cut out by CNC machine, out of the best 'BB' grade (void free) Baltic Birch Plywood.

New Ozite 'Spectropile' carpet made entirely out of 100% post consumer recycled plastic bottles, and designed for use on boats, so very tough & completely waterproof. It's not just to make them 'cuddly' though, the carpet is a excellent dampener of panel resonances.
